



Rodez heritage tour:

- Hôtel de Coignac - C19th** - Former Chamber of Commerce and Industry. This private mansion dates back to the late 19th century.
- Hôtel de Séguret - C17th** - A bourgeois mansion which belonged to an important family of magistrates.
- Hôtel de France - C18th** - It is a rare example of a French-style mansion in Rodez.
- Hôtel de Bonald - C16th** - This building was the residence of one of Rouergue's most prestigious families.
- Hôtel Delauro - C16th** - Former residence of a canon. It was later converted several times into a school and rectory. Today it houses the Compagnons du Devoir.
- Episcopal Palace - C17th** - The former bishop's palace is one of the rare monuments, between a courtyard and a garden, to be made of bricks. (As today closed to the public).
- Tour Corbières - C15th** - Built to counter the English threat, the medieval ramparts where originally composed of around twenty watchtowers, including Corbières Tower.
- Cathedral - C13th /C16th** - It took around 300 years to build it. This Cathedral is one of southern France largest cathedrals out of local pink sandstone. The main facade has no entrance gate as the cathedral was intended to be a city wall.
- House known as Maison Canoniale - C15th** - The restored entrance gate dates back to the 15th century. It still has a small window, an ancestor of our current peephole, and its knocker.
- Chapel of the former Jesuit College - C17th** - This chapel was originally part of a vast ensemble: the Jesuit college, which is now partially destroyed.
- Maison Trouillet - C15th** - A former multipurpose house which belonged to a family of important traders. The mullioned windows are decorated with ogee arches and pinnacles.
- Saint-Amans Church - C18th** - Initially built in the C12th, it was completely restored in the middle of the C18th. The church is dedicated to St. Amans, the first evangelist bishop of Rodez and its region. The outer facade is Baroque style.
- House known as Maison d'Armagnac - C16th** - This house belonged to a wealthy merchant and banker, Hugues Daulhou. Its facade merges with Gothic and Renaissance styles.
- Maison de l'Annonciation - C16th** - It was the property of a rich merchant, François Dardenne, and operated as a shop on the ground floor with residences on the upper floors. The corner turret decorated with a bas-relief is depicting a scene from the Annunciation.
- Hôtel de Jouéry (Fenaille Museum and Tourist Office) - C14th to C16th** - Its limestone facade is in the Renaissance style. The courtyard of this ancient residence, the heart of the museum and an architectural gem, is preserved. Next to the Hôtel de Jouéry is one of Rodez's oldest building (C12th).
- Remains of the forum - C1st** - In Gallo-Roman times, the forum, a place of public life and trade within the town, was located on this square. The only visible remains are the low wall situated at the entrance of the underground car park.
- Hôtel Lenormand d'Ayssènes - C18th** - The Prefecture was set up in this private mansion in 1825. On the facade, a medallion commemorates Jean Moulin, who was the prefect of Aveyron from 1937 to 1939.
- Maison Guitard - C14th** - Formerly the property of a family of bankers, the Guitard family. It is one of the oldest preserved houses in Rodez.
- Maison de Benoît - C15th** - This house has a beautiful inner courtyard with a flamboyant Gothic style balustrade.
- Soulages Museum - C21st** - Designed by the Catalan company "RCR Arquitectes", which won the Pritzker prize in 2017 for it, this museum pays tribute to the leading figure of abstract art : Pierre SOULAGES.
- Denys-Puech Museum - C20th** - Designed by André Boyer, it is the first Fine Arts museum established in Rodez.
